GATENET ACCESS

AVAILABLE

The GateNet database is a consortium of over 40 members located within the Lewis & Clark Library System. While GateNet members include both public and school libraries, the predominant group is public libraries. The database has over 730,000 bibliographic records and averages a monthly circulation of over 225,000 items.

GateNet is accessible to any library or individual with an Internet connection and Telnet capabilities. Members of the St. Louis Regional Library Network may access, search and request material located in the GateNet database. If your library is interested in viewing and using the GateNet database, please contact Charm Ruhnke at charm@lcls.lib.il.us or 618-656-3216 ext. 121 to have a borrowers account with username and password created for the library.

To access GateNet, go to the Lewis & Clark Library System's home page at <http://gatenet.lcls.lib.il.us/lclspg.html> once there, move down to the bottom of the page and click on Telnet Access. When Telnet Access is highlighted, click on the Access to the Database button and press the Enter key. Once the connection to GateNet has been made, you will be asked for your username and password. Enter both and you will be welcomed to the GateNet database.

THE NETWORK LISTSERV

Thanks to the work of Vera Weiskopf, Jeff Heustis, and Washington University, the St. Louis Regional Library Network now has its very own listserv. It is open to all members of the library community for sharing information about job openings, training opportunities, conferences, withdrawn library materials and equipment which may be useful to someone else, and any other library news you want to share.

1. To SUBSCRIBE to the list, send the message that follows to:

listserv@wuvmd.wustl.edu

Message: subscribe slrln-l first name last name
e.g. subscribe slrln-l Vera Weisskopf

This message is all you need. Anything else is extraneous and gets in the way.

2. To send a message to all subscribers, send message to:

SLRLN-L@WUVM.D.WUSTL.EDU

This address should be used ONLY for messages (mail) a member is sending to the list. It should NOT be used for sending commands.

3. All COMMANDS (e.g. concerning how or if you wish acknowledgement of messages you have sent to the list) must be sent to:

LISTSERV@WUVM.D.BITNET or
LISTSERV@WUVM.D.WUSTL.EDU

Information on LISTSERV COMMANDS can be obtained by sending a:

INFO REFCARD command to the command address given above (#3.)

EXAMPLES OF COMMANDS (send to LISTSERV address):

To remove yourself from the listserv: SIGNOFF SLRLN-L

To confirm that Listserv has received your messages to the lists:

To receive a copy of all your messages: SET SLRLN-L REPRO

To receive a short acknowledgement (rather than entire message):

SET SLRLN-L ACK NOREPRO

To eliminate any acknowledgements you may have requested:

SET SLRLN-L NOACK NOREPRO

To receive a list of archive files: INDEX SLRLN-L

To order an archive file: GET SLRLN-L LOGxxxx

To receive information on the LISTSERV's database research facilities:

INFO DATABASE

To see who is signed up on the list (names and email addresses):

REVIEW

To remain an anonymous member: SET SLRLN-L CONCEAL.

page. Instead of going to the Telnet Access,
click on the WWW Access. Currently the Web
catalog is searchable but requests are not
allowable.

Please note that when your library's
borrower account is created, you will also
receive more detailed directions on using
GateNet. If you have any questions, feel free
to contact Charm at Lewis & Clark.

Note: from Bernyce - to use this borrowing &
delivery system you need access to the SLRLN
delivery Route A.
